Graduate Traineeship Program

Application Guidelines

NDSLHA will be offering three \$500 traineeships for graduate study in speech-language pathology or audiology. The purpose of these traineeships is to support students in pursuing a graduate degree. The traineeships will be awarded in addition to any funding the applicant is able to secure from other sources.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicant must:

1. be a student member of the North Dakota Speech-Language-Hearing Association by the time the award is granted.
2. be accepted into or attending a graduate program.
3. be enrolled in at least six semester hours during the semester the traineeship is awarded.

Note: Preference will be given to those applicants who plan to work in North Dakota after the completion of the graduate degree (see application for more information).

Application Process

Applicant must:

1. Complete and submit the scholarship application

2. Submit 2 letters of reference. If currently employed as a speech-language paraprofessional or as an assistant, one of the references must be from the applicant's employer.
